REMINDER - Parents are asked to register their children for kindergarten as soon as possible!

***Children must be 5 years old by Dec 31, 2026**, to be eligible for kindergarten.

*A registration form will be completed at the time of registration.

*Parents are reminded to bring a piece of Government issued ID verifying proof of child's age, such as a birth certificate, PEI Health card or passport.

*Verification of home address must also be provided, such as a current utility bill.

*Welcome to Kindergarten sessions for incoming students and their parents will be held at the schools in the spring of 2026.

Food Support: It's hard to learn when you're hungry. Below are a few ways that MCS supports our kids' bellies.

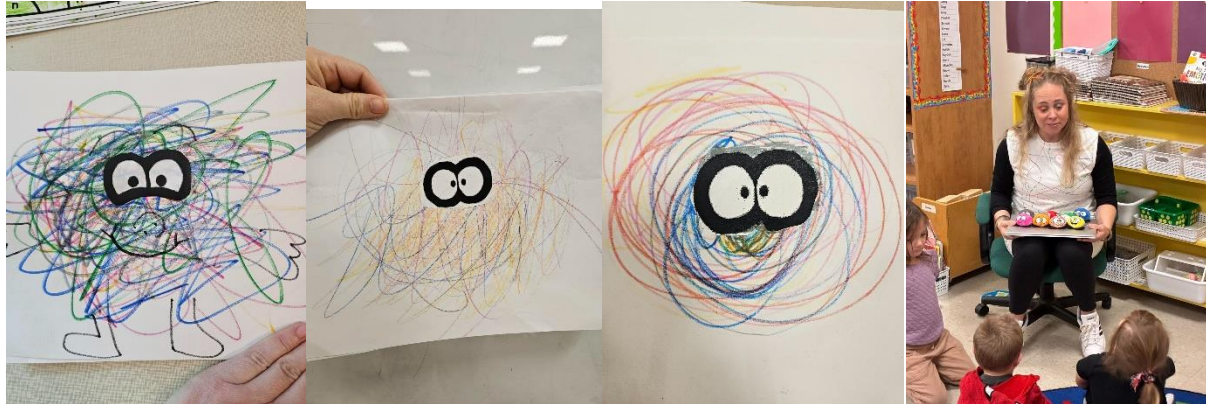
We have breakfast that anyone can take to class in the morning. The program ends as O'Canada starts so if you wish to use the program, please arrive on time. We make accommodation for late buses.
