All books must be returned to the school library by Friday June 12th, 2026.

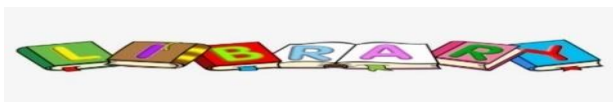

FOSTERING POSITIVE CONNECTIONS

WHAT IS IT

For every growth feedback, aim for 4 positive interactions to create a supportive environment

4 TO 1 IN PRACTICE

Examples of **Positive interactions:**
praising effort, celebrating progress, or encouraging ideas

Examples of **Growth Feedback:**
gentle redirection, re-teaching expectations to reinforce each student's potential

WHY IT WORKS (THE SCIENCE)

Research in positive behaviour supports shows a 4 to 1 ratio increases engagement, cooperation and learning outcomes.

HOW IT SUPPORTS ALL STUDENTS

A 4 to 1 balance shifts focus towards strengths, reinforcing positive behaviours and nurturing a growth mindset (the belief that skills grow with effort). This is particularly important for our neurodivergent learners.

PRACTICAL TIPS 4 HOME

- Praise efforts at home
- Notice small successes
- Balance growth feedback with positive interactions daily.
