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## **Arrival Information**

Please do not drop students off before 8:15 as we do not have anyone on supervision

8:15 Buses will be unloading in our bus lane at the front of the school

We will be using the doors at the main entrance and the entrance by the gym. Students may enter the school using the doors closest to the child's classroom.

**8:15** Parents/ Guardians must use the upper parking lot, when dropping students off. Parents/Guardians must remain in their vehicles during drop offs.

If your child is walking to school we encourage them to arrive between 8:20- 8:30.

## **Departure Information**

**\*\* Bus passes are no longer available for non-essential travel.** Students are to travel on their designated bus(es) unless change is essential (i.e. alternate child care).

Students will be dismissed at 2:45, or as close as possible to this time

### **Parent/Guardian Pick Up 2:45**

Parents/Guardians will be asked to remain in their vehicles, in the upper parking lot. A staff member will escort your child to the car to ensure the child's safety. If a parent/guardian is running late the student will remain in the office area of the school.

### **Parking Lot Designations**

The parking lot closest to Montessori, will be used for pick up and drop off of students in the morning and afternoon. This parking lot will not be used during the school day for any traffic. The drive through lane will be used for only buses in the morning and afternoon. This lane may be used during the school day from 9 am to 2 pm for drop off and pick up of students. The lower parking lot closest to the gym is for staff only.

We have adjusted these parking designations for the safety of our students, thank you in advance for following these designation.

## **Daily Routine, Food, Recess**

Students arrive and go directly to their homeroom.

Breakfast Program is grab and go at this time. Students are able to grab something from the breakfast table on their way to their classroom.

Hot Lunch Program will be delivered to the homerooms, Grades 3-6 will eat from 11:15 – 11:35 and students in K-2 will eat at 11:35 – 12:00.

Students will need snacks and their own lunch.

Students will need to have a water bottle and can use the water filling stations through out the school.

## **Students ready for learning**

Please remember to make sure your child is feeling well enough to participate in school before you send the student to school. A rule of thumb is, if someone has a fever, vomiting or diarrhea then the individual should stay home for 24 hours.
